

Signature of a Memorandum of Understanding authorizing the CNDP to use the technical features of the CNIE

Rabat, March 31st, 2022.

In view of the deployment of the National Trusted Third Party dedicated to the authentication of digital service users, CNDP (Commission Nationale de contrôle de la protection des Données à caractère Personnel) and DGSN (Direction Générale de la Sûreté Nationale) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding for the CNDP's own dematerialization platforms' requirements, which are currently being developed. Therefore, through this protocol, DGSN authorizes the CNDP to use the technical features of the CNIE.

Thus, the CNDP is the first public institution to be given this authorization by the DGSN.

The use of this National Trusted Third Party dedicated to the authentication of digital service users shall be aligned with the deliberations of the CNDP, particularly:

- N°D-108-EUS/2020 of 23/04/2020 relating to the definition of the use of facial recognition technologies as part of the remote account system used by banks and payment institutions.
- N°D-120-2020 of 08/07/2020 on the identification architecture, which is the cornerstone of any digitization policy, as well as its deliberation.
- N°D-126-EUS-2020 of 07/29/2020 relating to the definition of the use of facial recognition technologies by social welfare institutions for beneficiaries' proof of life.
- N°D-195-EUS/2020 of 30/12/2020 relating to the definition of the use of facial recognition technologies.

About the CNDP

The protection of privacy in Morocco is guaranteed by Article 24 of the Constitution of the Kingdom: "Everyone has the right to the protection of his or her private life...".

The CNDP (Commission Nationale de contrôle de la protection des Données à caractère personnel) was established by the Dahir n° 1-09-15 of 22 safar 1430 (18 February 2009) promulgating the law n° 09-08 related to the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data.
